

## **DRESS CODE**

We ask everyone, members, members' guests and visitors alike, to conform to these standards. Those who knowingly disregard the Dress Code may be asked by a Committee Member or member of staff to dress appropriately or leave the course or clubhouse.

**The following are not permitted either on or off the course: TRAINERS, COMBAT TROUSERS, TRACK SUITS, TEE SHIRTS OR SHIRTS WITH INAPPROPRIATE OR LARGE LOGOS**

### **ACCEPTABLE DRESS ON THE COURSE**

**Dress must at all times be suitable for the game of golf.**

**Standard Golf Clothing**

**Golf Shoes** (No trainers)

**Tailored Shorts** (not shorts designed for other sports or beach wear) must be worn with socks.

**Socks** – Long, Ankle, Sports Socks, Sockettes

**Skirts**

**Long Trousers, Plus Twos & Plus Fours** (Trousers not to be tucked into socks and **NO JEANS**)

**Shirts** – Collared, Polo or Turtle Neck **MUST BE TUCKED IN** unless specifically designed to be worn outside trousers or skirts

### **ACCEPTABLE DRESS IN THE CLUBHOUSE**

The dress acceptable on the Course is also acceptable in the Bar and Dining Room but **GOLF SHOES are not permitted in the Lobby, Bar or Dining Room. All hats and caps to be removed in the Clubhouse, please.**

**Smart Casual Wear** with the exceptions already listed above.
